Rules for submission of work:

1. Your work should be recent, i.e. produced within the last 24 months, and should be based on any part or whole of the Staffordshire Way.
2. Photos, artwork, poems etc. should be the original work of the person submitting them.
3. Digital photographs can be submitted in standard 3:2 ratio, *should be in landscape* mode (in preference to portrait), JPG format and 3Mb to 10 Mb file size.
4. Flat artwork, of up to A3 size, can be submitted as it is or you may submit good quality photographs, viewable at A4 size, of your artwork.
5. If you have created 3D artwork, such as a sculpture, please send in good quality photos, that can be viewed at A4 size, of different angles.
6. Written work, such as poetry, can be sent in as a MS Word file, plain text file or PDF document.
7. Artists, photographers and writers will retain copyright for their work, CPRE Staffordshire maintain the right to exhibit and use submissions in print & online & will credit entrants accordingly.
8. You may submit a combination of written & visual works.
9. Submission of work is acceptance of the rules above.
