	Optional: attending planning committee meetings or residents' meetings for major developments of concern.
	Optional: drafting responses to planning applications for approval by the planning committee (training will be given).
What's in it for you?	Opportunities to take part in online training from the national CPRE charity about the planning process and how to respond to applications.
	Advice from our planning advisor and committee members about what to focus on when flagging up applications, as well as on how to respond to an application.
	The opportunity to increase your knowledge of the planning system and to help protect the countryside.
