## Come and help us plant a hedge at Pasford Farm on the Staffordshire/Shropshire border: Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February, 10 to 1pm

CPRE Shropshire is partnering up with the Staffordshire Wildlife Trust and our colleagues at CPRE Staffordshire to come and plant a hedge in a rather special place on the Staffordshire/Shropshire border.

Come and help us plant a new native hedgerow in a beautiful valley managed for its wildlife and birds. The new 260 metre hedge will join up all the existing hedges on this site thus creating a fantastic continuous wildlife corridor for the birds and animals that live there.

Spades are provided. Please bring gardening gloves and wear stout, waterproof boots/wellies and warm waterproofs!

Planting is a great experience, working outside in interesting locations with like-minded people doing something really practical for nature in lovely Shropshire countryside.

The volunteer lead will make sure you know what to do if you have not planted before.

Hot drinks/biscuits/cake will be available during the morning.
